

Crossroads - answers

What advice will you give to learners to help them to recognise the location of a crossroad?

Look out for direction signs, warning signs, give way & stop signs, gaps in houses, gaps in trees or bushes on rural roads and traffic movement ahead.

How might you gain extra opportunities to teach crossroad skills?

By highlighting gateways that are opposite at T junctions when emerging.

If 'offside to offside' passing is the safest method of turning right at crossroads, why is 'nearside to nearside' the most common?

This is sometimes because of traffic volume and sometimes because the road layout would make offside to offside impractical.

What simple method can you use to help your pupils remember to check all the roads before entering a crossroad junction?

The '1, 2, 3' method.
