The instructor's attitude must reflect concern, understanding, responsibility and professionalism when:

- dealing with pupils
- choosing methods of instruction
- maintaining/presenting the training vehicle
- dealing with other road users
- dealing with the authorities

Why is it important to maintain a high standard of driving after qualification?

If you are not in the habit of driving to a high standard you will not expect high standards of driving from your pupils. Poor driving standards will also be noticed by the public and could have a negative impact on business.
